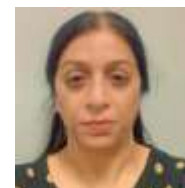

## MyChildatSchool

One simple app, countless problems solved



MyChildAtSchool is an online portal that enables parents to view their child's performance at school in real time. Access is via a web browser or an app (for Android or iOS) and offers visibility of attendance, behaviour, assessment, student reports, letters, important documents and much more. It also provides a School shop front, taking online payments for anything from Trips, Clubs and Meals to Uniforms, Donations and Products.



### Access to Real-time Data

All the data is in real time so a parent can instantly see whether his/her child is in school now.



### Personal Account Settings

Parents can update their personal contact details online so that the school always has their most up to date information.



### Announcements

Allows the school to communicate with all parents or focus on a selected audience based on student groups, including attaching documents.



### Timetable and Academic Calendar

Parents can see which lessons their child has and with whom as well as having access to school events in calendar format.



# School Counselling Service

- Two counsellors will be in school each week, from Space4U
- Sessions on a Wednesday and Thursday
- Each session lasts for one lesson
- Students will not miss the same lesson each week – it will be rotated
- Aim is to support our students with any problems or worries and support them to help themselves
- Counselling can help young people to understand their feelings better and consider their own strengths, and help them to make their own decisions

# Free School Meals

- Changes to Free school meals eligibility
- Free school meals (FSM) available to students whose households receive Universal Credit.
- FSM allowance is £2.65. This means your child has enough allowance to purchase a meal deal
- Reception available if you need support with your application or call 0116 454 1009 (option 3)

# Pupil Premium Provision

- Access to device loan for support with schoolwork (laptop and dongle)
- Your child receives a grant of £60 for years 7-9 and £100 for years 10-11. This can be spent on items from the school shop which stocks items such as stationery
- Breakfast Club and Library Club are available for all students to access from 7.45am in the morning. At Breakfast Club your child can get a free breakfast
- Compulsory curriculum items, such as English texts like A Christmas Carol, and revision guides are purchased for your child
- In year 11 we offer free tutoring with Aim13
