Dear Parents/Carers,

We have received one or two community reports of young people engaging in unsafe behaviour, including climbing on buildings and other structures. Please remind your child to make sensible choices, stay aware of their surroundings, and prioritise their safety at all times. Working together, we can help ensure all students remain safe within the community.
