Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope that this letter reaches you in the best of health and circumstances.

As we approach the end of year, I wanted to thank you for all of your support over the past 12 months. It has been amazing to see what your children have achieved in that time and I am extremely grateful for your support. It was particularly pleasing to see you at the #Success evenings, sports awards and investiture event.

Attendance

We will be finishing the year on approximately 94.4% as a college. This is an increase on last year but still short of where we want to be. The main reasons for us not meeting our target has been holidays during term time and taking more than one religious day holiday for religious observance. The biggest impact that poor attendance has, is on the progress of your child and their learning.

A reminder we have breakfast club which opens from 7.45am (entrance from Gwendolen road). Added to this, gates open at 8.20am to allow students to be in school on time to avoid sanctions. If students are late to school there will be in detention until 3.55pm on the same day.

Uniform

Please can we ask parents to be organised with their purchasing of uniform. Please also note when buying footwear that it meets the school requirements. Trainer like shoes are not permitted. Please see the website for pictures and further details. From August we will be ensuring our high standards are continued.

A reminder around our makeup policy which has remained unchanged, "light and not excessive". To give clarity any acrylic nails, eyelashes, non-natural tones of makeup are not permitted and will need to be rectified. We would also like to remind parents that much time is often wasted by young children in the toilets checking hair and makeup. This is not the culture we want for them.
